1 Murfreesboro City Schools recognizes the importance of the connection between nutrition, physical 2 activity and academic achievement. In order to implement overall wellness for students, the district

4 representatives of the school food authority, students, parents, administrators, and any interested citizens

5 to participate in the development of wellness policies and practices.

13 This individual will be responsible for overseeing the implementation of Coordinated School Health

14 programming at all schools pursuant to federal and State requirements, including (1) providing annual

15 professional development related to the eight components of the CSH program, (2) implementing the

16 School Health Index, and (2) documenting that the school wellness policy and triennial assessments are

17 made available to the public.

18 SCHOOL HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL

19 The Director of Schools shall establish a district-level School Health Advisory Council to serve as a

- resource for schools in implementing these procedures. The Director of Schools shall appoint members to the Advisory Council on an annual basis and the Coordinated School Health Supervisor shall be
- responsible for scheduling meetings on a regular basis and communicating with the Advisory Council.
- The district will consider the recommendations of the School Health Advisory Council in making any
- 24 policy changes that affect the healthy learning environment.

25 HEALTHY SCHOOL TEAMS

26 Each school principal shall establish a Healthy School Team for their school. The team shall include the

27 principal, teachers, staff, students, parents, and community members with at least one-half of the team

- 28 members being non-school personnel. The school principal shall appoint members to the Healthy School
- 29 Team on an annual basis. The Healthy School Team shall assess needs and oversee planning and
- 30 implementation of school health efforts at the school site.
