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Federal rules and regulations stipulate that the Child Nutrition Supervisor is responsible for overseeing the operation of the district's food service program. This oversight includes the general management and control of all aspects of the program pertaining to federal, state, and local laws, rules, regulations, and policies dealing with the operation, health requirements, and guidelines of the child nutrition program.

At the individual school level, cafeteria managers, under the guidance of the Child Nutrition Supervisor, are responsible for carrying out the on-site daily operation of the food service program ensuring that the cafeterias meet acceptable standards for food preparation, food service, sanitation and cleanliness.

In order to provide the best dining environment and experience possible, the cafeteria manager and Child Nutrition Supervisor shall work in concert with the individual school principal to coordinate the service times, methods of service delivery, activities, and events in and around the cafeteria service at the school. In addition, the Child Nutrition Supervisor shall work with the school principal when personnel issues occur.
