- 1 Under Title I, Part C of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) our school district
- 2 provides supplemental services to the children of agricultural workers who have recently moved.
- 3 Identification of students is done by completion of the Parent Occupational Survey.
- 4 An Occupational Survey is completed for every student at the time of enrollment into the school
- 5 system and every year thereafter.
- 6 The Tennessee Parent Occupational Survey can be found as part of the online enrollment packet.
- School enrollment personnel reviews surveys. If the survey has NO on questions #1 and/or #2, it
 is filed at the school.
- 9 If a parent or guardian marks YES on both questions #1 and #2, the survey is forwarded to
- 10 migrant liaison, via courier, or email, to review.
- 11 A member of the district's outreach team contacts the parent or guardian to verify their 12 understanding of the questions asked.
- Once validity of answers is verified for questions #1 and #2, forms are forwarded to the Migrant Education Program (MEP).
- 15 Once the MEP team certifies students, data is pulled from Arroyo to complete Individual Needs
- 16 Assessment or input any missing information by the migrant liaison.
- 17 If students are identified as migrant, a referal is made to the school counselor to assess and 18 provide school resouces needs.
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- 20 In additon, migrant students are referred to school social worker to assess and provide
- 21 community based resources.
