Collaborating & Networking

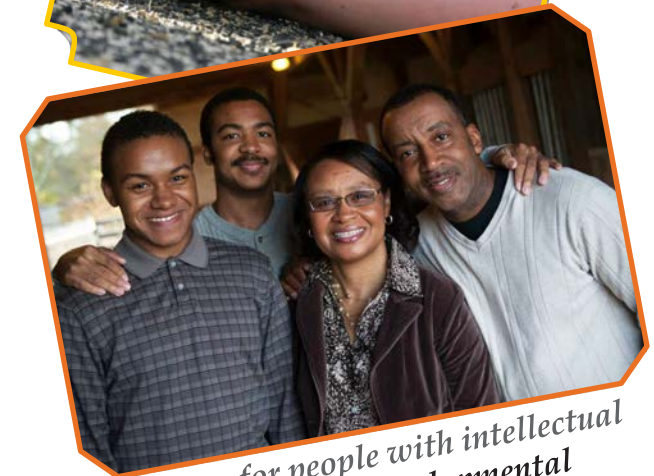
