What's a Little Free Library?

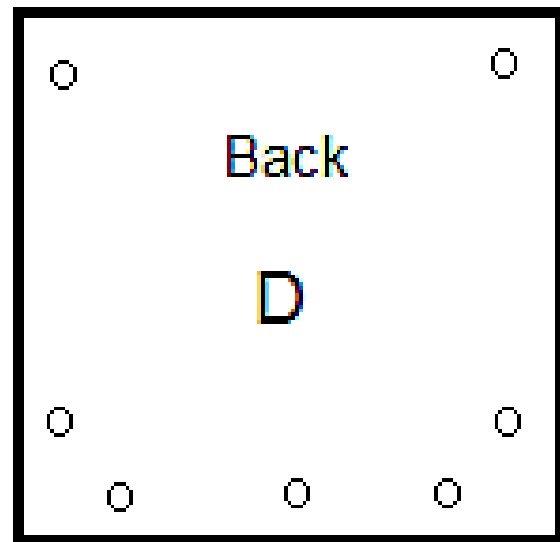
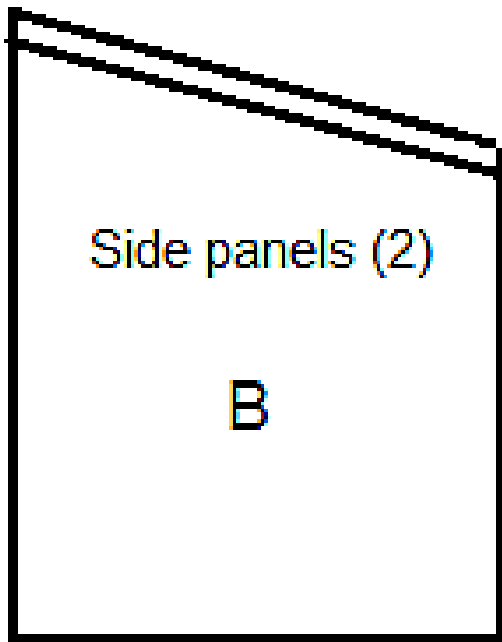
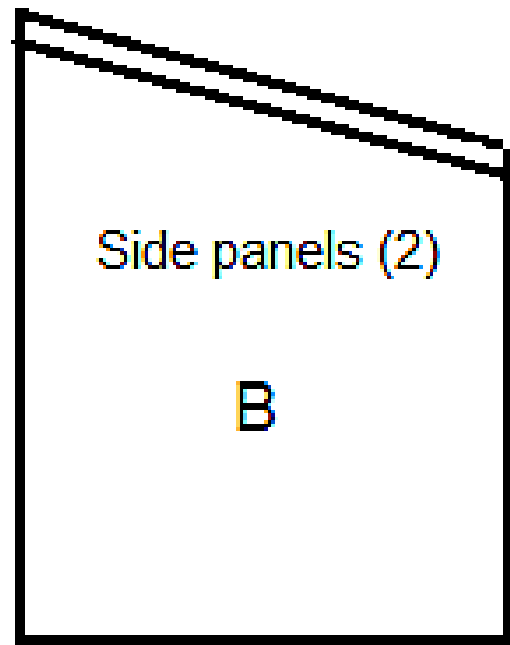
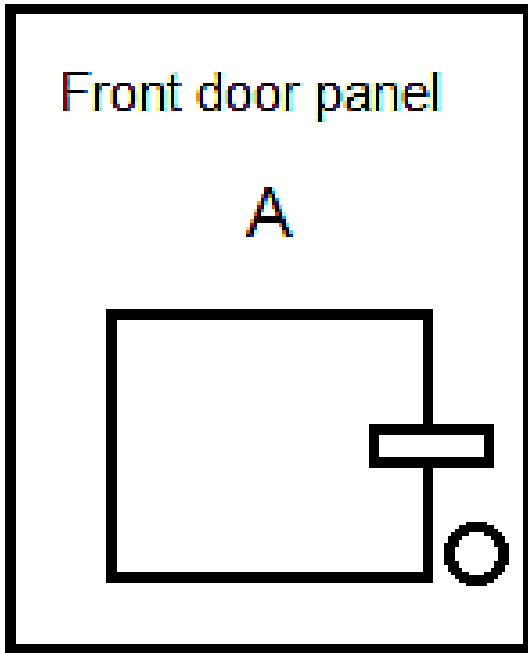
