AUGUST 21, 2017

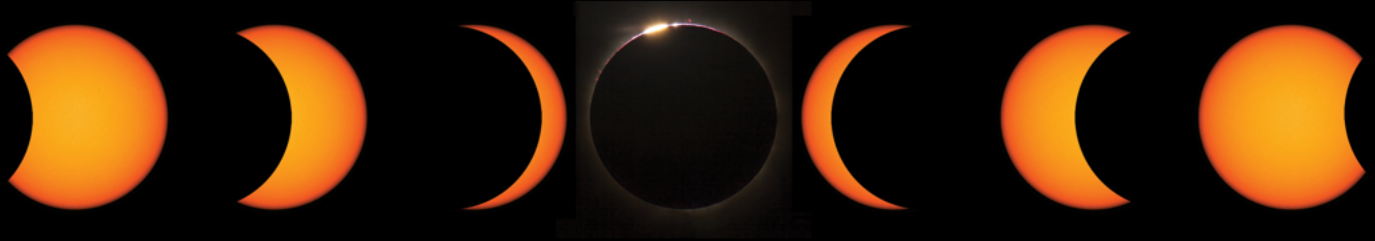
