TRADITIONAL SCHOOL SETTING

Parents can choose for their child to move from Distance Learning to the traditional classroom setting. Simply, email your school principal or classroom teacher to let them know your choice. If your child is currently enrolled in the traditional classroom, no action is required.

DISTANCE LEARNING

A choice distance learning parent agreement must be completed for parents to opt children out of the traditional school setting. This form can be found on Skyward Family Access. Principal approval is required. Parents currently choosing the Distance Learning option must complete a new agreement before Dec. 13.

Unless the school district moves to another instruction plan, all students must remain in the instruction plan they start until the end of a nine-week grading period. **All parents choosing distance learning, including parents currently utilizing choice distance learning, must complete a new opt-out form located in Skyward Parent Portal.**
