What can we do to renew Rutherford together?

- 1. Students must be Murfreesboro City or Rutherford County residents in kindergarten through high school grades.
- 2. Submissions should focus on the theme "What can we do to renew Rutherford together?"
- **3.** The poster must have some design or artwork depicting the theme or slogan. For examples, visit the website **cityschools.net/2023-earth-day** or scan the QR listed below.
- 4. The finished poster should measure at least 8 ½ x 14 inches and not exceed 28 x 30 inches.
- 5. All participants must submit a completed participation form or Google form. You can find the google form at <u>cityschools.net/2023-earth-day</u>. Then student, teacher and school should be written on the back of the poster, top-right corner.
- **6.** All submitted entries will remain the property of the Earth Day Committee jointly with their corresponding departments and companies.
- **7.** This can be an individual, group, class or family project.

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Complete contest rules must be followed at all levels of the competition. Incomplete packages and incorrectly sized posters will not be eligible for judging.
- 2. Artwork will be judged on:
 - a. Creativity.
 - **b.** Reflection of the contest theme and slogan.
 - **c.** Originality in design.
